Bennett Lumber, Princeton, Idaho, very unhappy with the transit time on KDTX cars moving via our road to the east and are threatening to take business away from us due to the length of time it takes to move them over our road.

For example, KDTX 168 received from the BN at Spokane under load on October 22, lost two days at Avery, one day at Deer Lodge, bad order at Aberdeen for three days. KDTX 160, bad order at Miles City for three days and at Aberdeen seven days account shifted load, again delayed St. Paul three days account broken journal bearing. Car was on our line 18 days, of which the car was actually moving five days. KDTX 132 lost four days at St. Paul bad order. KDTX 198 lost two days at Harlowton due to extra east not moving thru and putting the car on 262 two days later. The majority of the delays to these cars appear to be the time lost due to being bad order.

I am giving Mr. Christiansen a copy of this letter in the hopes that perhaps he can check their loading to see if this can be improved and if something can be done to see that the cars are repaired more promptly. Perhaps we can again satisfy this very important customers' deeds. TACOMA - December 14, 1972

Bennett Lumber at Princeton, Idaho threatening to cut us out of their business, due to the way we are handling their loads and their empties returning.

On October 26, D. O. Burke issued instructions that KDTX and BENX empties returning to Bennett Lumber at Princeton, Idaho were to be handled on 263 to Plummer and then taken back to St. Maries. I find that the cars are being taken into Spokane and then going to St. Maries, causing an extra two or three days delay, which they are very, very unhappy about.

Mr. Gary Bennett was quite strong in his criticism of the transit time on these cars when he called us on December 6th. We realize Mr. Bennett is counting the time from billing to delivery; however, our own transit time needs some looking into. Another item we should look into is the possibility of delays prior to our receiving the car. The spread of 2 days to 5 days appears strange. True, this delay is on another railroad, but it is one we must consider if we are to solicit this traffic through the Western Gateway.

Still another item we should look at is the use of the Terre Haute line on this business. We may earn a few extra dollars via those junctions, but is it worth it at the expense of perhaps losing the business entirely?

Believe me, Mr. Bennett indicates he is looking long and hard at the transit times on his cars to determine whether or not he will continue to route these cars via BN-Spokane-MILW.

Your serious consideration of this problem and comments on these particular cars would be greatly appreciated.
