At Enumclaw, all trains will be cleared from Northern Pacific telegraph office.

Trains need not obtain clearance card at Bagley Jct. or Kerriston Jct.

All trains reduce speed approaching and passing through yard limits at Selleck expecting to find main track occupied.

CMSTP&P way freight trains between Cedar Falls and Enumclaw are authorized to carry passengers.

At Enumclaw, a new track has been constructed leading from main track, 2600 ft. east of Northern Pacific Depot, connecting with White River Lumber Co's. track, and this track crosses highway at

grade.
All movements of engine or cars over this highway must be protected by flagman.

Derail 330 ft. west of junction switch at Bagley Jct.

Derail one-half mile west of Selleck.

Yard limit signs are located as follows:

Bagley Jct. and Kerriston Jct.—Yard limits extend from 1000 ft. west of Kerriston Jct. to main track derail Bagley Jct.

Selleck—2100 ft. east of east switch—3000 ft. west of west switch.

Bayne Jct. and Bayne—2600 ft. east of east switch Bayne Jct.—2600 ft. west of west switch Bayne.

Enumclaw—2000 ft. east of east switch—2000 ft. west of west switch.

2000 ft. east of White River Lumber Co's. switch.
